Certificate of Appropriateness 22045 Hwy 59

Certificate of Appropriateness 22324 Level Street

The request is to enclose three (3) sides of an existing carport. The carport is located at the corner of Pine Street and Level Street. The carport will be covered in board and batten siding including an existing cinder block wall. The carport will be painted the same color as the house. The applicant will make hinged doors for the carport that will be painted to match the house or stained.

The Commission reviewed the 2020 approval of an addition to the house that is yet to be constructed. Discussion ensued regarding the roof slope.

Commissioner Mancil motioned to approve the request as presented. Commissioner Dinkelacker seconded the motion. All commissioners were in favor. The application is assigned to Commissioner Mancil.
