All accessory buildings shall be limited to a height not to exceed 35 feet. 17 18 d. - 9 Section I. The attached estimate of revenues for the year beginning January 01, 2020 and ending
- 10 December 31, 20120 be and the same is hereby adopted to serve as an operating budget of revenues for the
- 11 Town of Abita Springs during the same period.
- 12 Section II. The attached estimates of the expenditures for the year beginning January 01, 2020 and ending
- 13 December 31, 2020 serve as a budget of expenditures for the Town of Abita Springs during the same period.
- 14 Section III. The adoption of this operating budget of expenditures be and this hereby to operate as an
- 15 appropriation of the amount therein set forth within the terms of the budget classification.
- 31 Section IV. The Mayor may authorize transfer between line items of expenditures within a function or department,
- 32 provided that such transfers shall not exceed 10% of the total department budget. The Council shall be notified in
- 33 writing by the Mayor of aforesaid transfers exceeding 5%. All other budget adjustments must be approved by the
- 34 Mayor and Council as a whole.

# A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF ABITA SPRINGS RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING OF SHORT TERM RENTALS

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Abita Springs has adopted an ordinance to regulate the operation of short term rentals, and;

**WHEREAS**, that ordinance provides that rules concerning procedures and priorities may be adapted by resolution of the Board of Aldermen, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to adopt such rules, and;

**THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED,** by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Abita Springs, that the following rules pertaining to the regulation of the operation of short term rental of lodging in Abita Springs:

- 1. Any short term rental enterprise that provides proof of operation of business for a period of six months prior to November 15, 2019 shall be granted a permit to operate a short term rental under the following conditions:
  - a. Such proof shall consist of:
    - i. Advertisement for lodging
    - ii. Occupational License
    - iii. Evidence of rental payments made by renters
  - b. The premises providing short term rental complies with all requirements of the Abita Springs Code of Ordinances.
  - c. The application period for permits by such pre-existing short term rentals shall commence November 4, 2019.
- 2. A waiting list shall be maintained by the Town of Abita Springs of applicants who did not receive permits solely due to the unavailability of allowed permits. The Town shall notify such applicants in the order that they appear on the waiting list of any availability that may occur during the year subsequent to the date of the annual issuance of permits. An applicant must reapply within 10 days of notice of such permit availability. Thereafter the next applicant on the waitlist shall be notified and allowed to apply for that permit. Being placed on the waiting list does not create a vested right in any applicant.
- 3. Application may be submitted and considered by the Town at any time that there remains available permits for short term rental.
- 4. During the application process the applicant may be given the opportunity to amend its application by the Planning Director or the Planning and Zoning Commission without forfeiting its position in the priority of applications to be considered.
- 5. The application fee shall be \$25.00 to be paid by cash or certified check
